BBQ COOK-OFF

RULES & REGULATIONS

1. Contestants must have **completed & signed** the registration form, read the rules & regulations form & paid entire entry fee in order to hold a space. Spaces are on a first come first serve basis.
2. One judged entry per spot extra entries can be purchased for \$50.00.
3. Contestants must be at least 18 years old and Represent a Lodge. .
- 4.. Contestants will furnish all needed supplies and equipment.
5. **PRE-COOKED MEAT IS NOT PERMITTED** raw meat only contestants begin cooking after 12 p.m. on Fri-day; only after their meats have been inspected by BBQ Cook-Off Director.
6. Cookers can begin setup Thursday, May 16th starting at 4 p.m.. Cookers may stay the night Thursday, May 16th, but there will be **NO** loud music or partying allowed. Failure to follow these rules will result in your team being disqualified.
7. No sauce or condiments are to be placed in the judging container.
8. Fires must be wood or wood substances; holes or cooking pits are forbidden. Any equipment or device that damages the site is prohibited.
9. Each cooking team is required to have on site fire extinguishers for A, B, & C fires, with a minimum of 5 lbs. pressure. Cooking areas may be inspected at any time and disqualified if it is determined they are dangerous or create a safety hazard in any way.
10. The Head Cook is responsible for the conduct of all members and guests of their team. Excessive alcohol use, music volume, profanity and/or unacceptable conduct, as so deemed by the BBQ Cook-Off Director, will be disqualified; entry fees and awards will be forfeited. Excessive loud music will not be allowed after

12 a.m. Friday, May 17th and after 10 p.m. following the awards on Saturday, May 18, 2013; 1st warning, 2nd disqualification.

11. Barbecue may not be sold to the public.

12. Judges and BBQ Committee decisions are final.

13. Trash receptacles will be placed in the contest area for contestant use.

Contestants are responsible for the cleanliness of their site and area and restrooms. Areas must be clean & presentable at all times.

14. All equipment shall be removed from the contest site after the Masonic Oak picnic Sunday, May 19, 2012..
